

THE SCOVILLE WILDLIFE SCHOLARSHIP

Roland “Bud” Scoville was an avid hunter and fisherman who knew and loved the wildlife in Cayuga County. As owner and operator of “Bud’s Bait and Tackle Shop” in Auburn, he enjoyed sharing his knowledge of the environment and wildlife in Cayuga County. In his memory, Bud’s family and friends have set aside funds for a scholarship to be awarded annually in his memory.

Concept: This one-year award will be given to qualified students who desire to pursue a career in wildlife management or environmental science.

Eligibility: Any graduating senior from any school in Cayuga County may apply. Applicants must plan to pursue a career in wildlife or environmental concerns. Award recipients must prove matriculation in a two- or four-year college or vocational institution.

Selection: One award in the amount of \$500 will be given each year. Awards will be based on the application form, recommendations, school grade point average, and an essay written by the applicant. In the event that the selected recipient does not enter a college or vocational school in the calendar year of his/her selection, the award will go to an alternate, chosen at the time of the original selection.

Selection Committee: The selection committee will include, but not be limited to family and friends of Roland “Bud” Scoville or their designees. If possible, a member of the Scoville family will present the award.

How to Apply:

1. Complete the attached application.
2. Include 2 references (forms attached) – one from a school counselor or principal, one from a person familiar with the student’s involvement in wildlife and environmental interests.
3. Attach a one page typed essay describing past involvement in wildlife and environmental interests, career plans, etc.

Return completed application to the school’s guidance office, who will then forward to the scholarship committee (c/o Mrs. Cindy Scoville, PO Box 326, Cayuga, NY 13034).
