Requirements:

- Eligible applicants must be graduating Port Byron high school seniors. High school transcript sent by school official.
- Two letters of recommendation. One will be a personal recommendation and the other will be academic/athletic recommendation. Letters shall not exceed 1000 words. Letters shall be sent from the authors to the contact information.
- A personal essay outlining significant achievements, community involvement, work history, and how the award will be used to achieve life goals. The essay shall not exceed 1500 words.
- Submission deadline is 1 May 2021.

- Scholarship(s) will be presented at graduation ceremony.
